The immediate survey was that victim had a pulse, was breathing, and was trying to communicate; they had an obstruction in their mouth, which was removed via finger-swipe technique after positioning their head to enable the mouth to open. Once they began coughing, they were turned onto their side, when they began to vomit. At this time, the EMS personnel arrived on the scene and took over the medical assistance. Victim continued to vomit and was able to communicate with the EMS personnel. The EMS personnel's plan was to take victim to area hospital via helicopter, which was accomplished.
