Currently Swimmers can enter the sectional meet with proof of time that is not allowed by our state meet. This should be changed so that every proof allowed at the higher level meet is acceptable at the lower level meet.

Current Rule : 5. For State Meet qualifying proof of times for events not contained in the State Meet Qualifying Times Database, MS will accept all times from any USA Swimming Sanctioned, Observed or Approved Meet as well as times from Invitational Meets and League or Conference Championship Meets hosted by other leagues or high schools that are run on approved meet management software and within the qualifying period. Times from dual, inter-squad or intra-squad meets which have not been sponsored by USA Swimming will not be accepted.

Requested New Rule or Procedure: For State Meet qualifying proof of times for events not contained in the State Meet Qualifying Times Database, MS will accept all times from any USA Swimming Sanctioned, Observed or Approved Meet as well as times from College, High School, Junior High, YWCA or YMCA Meets sanctioned by their respective governing organizations that are run on approved meet management software and within the qualifying period.
