MS rules, safety, and warm up procedures will govern the meet as if fully set forth in these meet rules.

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. There will be at least two safety marshals at this competition, with at least one of each gender.

Facilities

Dexter Community Pool is a 6-lane pool with a supervised warm-up and warm down area available. Depth at start is 7' 0"1 and 3' 6" at turn. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. Colorado timing system with a 6-lane display will be used. There is ample balcony seating for spectators. Lockers are available (provide your own lock). Public phones will not be available.

Course Certification

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4)

Meet Format

This meet is a timed final meet for those swimmers with "A", "B", "C" times. 500 Free and 400 IM events will be seeded fastest to slowest alternating gender.

Eligibility

All athletes and clubs registered with Michigan Swimming or another USA Swimming LSC are eligible to participate in this meet.

Entry Procedures

Entries may be submitted to the Administrative Official as of 10/11/24 at 8:00am. The Administrative Official must receive all entries no later than 11/01/24 at 8:00pm. Entries must include the correct swimmer name (as registered with USA/MS Swimming), age and USA number. All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail at the e-mail address listed in the last section of this meet information packet.

Entry Acceptance and Processing

Entries will be accepted and processed on a first come, first served basis in the order in which they are received after the entry open date listed above.

Individual Entry Limits

Swimmers may enter a maximum of two (2) events on Friday, and four (4) events per day on Saturday and Sunday.

Entry Fees

\$5.00 per individual event. Make checks payable to DCAC.

Surcharges

A \$1.00 per athlete Michigan Swimming athlete surcharge applies.

Refunds

Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the Administrative Official there are no refunds in full or in part unless the "over qualification exception" applies (see MS Rules).

Check In

Check-in will be required and will be available 15 minutes prior to warm-up. Check-in will be in the entry hallway outside the locker rooms. Failure to check-in will result in the swimmer being scratched from all events in that session. Check-in will close 15 minutes after the start of warm-up for each session.

Marshaling

This is a self-marshaled meet.

Seeding

Seeding will be done after check-in closes. All events are timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest other than the **500 Freestyle and 400 IM** which will be seeded fastest to slowest alternating gender women/men. Swimmers who fail to check in will be scratched from that day's events.

Deck Entries

Deck entries may be allowed if time and space permit and at the sole discretion of the Meet Referee and Meet Director. Deck entries will be accepted by the Clerk of Course. Deck entries are \$7.00 per individual event. There are NO time trials offered at this meet. Deck entries are subject to the Michigan Swimming \$1.00 general surcharge if they are not already in the meet. For athletes not already entered in the meet, registration status must be proven by showing an electronic USA Swimming Membership Card on the USA Swimming Website or USA Swimming app.

Meet Programs/Admissions

Admissions will be \$5.00 per person. Full meet programs will be available for 5.00.

Scoring

There will be no scoring at this meet.

Awards

Awards are for 12 & Under events only and will be awarded for each age group. Custom medals will be awarded for all divisions (A,B,C) for 1st – 3rd place. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th – 12th places. All awards will be given to coaches at the end of the Sunday session.

Results

Complete Official meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at http://www.miswim.org/. Unofficial results will also be available on flash drive (HY-TEK Team Manager result file) upon request. Teams must provide their own flash drive.

Concessions

Food and beverages will be available in the pool lobby. No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials.

Lost and Found

Articles may be turned in/picked up at the pool office. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained by the Meet Director or a representative for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).

Swimming Safety

Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool and diving well. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee which may include ejection from the meet.

Racing Start Certification

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Deck Personnel/Locker Rooms/Credentialing

Only registered and current coaches, athletes, officials and meet personnel are allowed on the deck or in locker rooms. Access to the pool deck may only be granted to any other individual in the event of emergency through approval by the Meet Director or the Meet Referee. The Michigan Swimming Board of Directors, Officials Chairs of MS, and the Michigan Swimming Office staff are authorized deck personnel at all MS meets. Personal assistants/helpers of athletes with a disability shall be permitted when requested by an athlete with a disability or a coach of an athlete with a disability.

All individuals seeking access to the pool deck must show a valid digital USA Swimming membership card reflecting good standing in order to receive a deck credential. The credential must be displayed at all times during the meet and will include the host team name as well as the function of the individual being granted access to the pool deck (Coach, Official, Timer, or Meet Personnel). In order to obtain a credential, Coaches and Officials must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet. Meet personnel must return the credential at the conclusion of working each day and be reissued a credential daily.

All access points to the pool deck and locker rooms will either be secured or staffed by a meet worker checking credentials throughout the duration of the meet.

Swimmers with Disabilities

All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests, please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.

First Aid

Supplies will be kept in Pool Office.

Medical Supervision

Medical supervision available will be lifeguards. AED devices are present. First aid supplies

are located in the pool office or lifequard.

Facility Items

- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of any facility listed above.
- (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
- (C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions.
- (D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by the Host Club to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection at the pool office.
- (E) To comply with USA Swimming privacy and security policy, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- (F) Deck changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes is **prohibited**.
- (G) Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

General Information and Errors/Omissions

Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the Meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.
