Sanction – This meet is sanctioned by Michigan Swimming, Inc. (MS), as a timed final meet on behalf of USA Swimming (USA-S), Sanction Number **MI2526023**. In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Inc. and Michigan Swimming, Inc. shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event. MS rules, safety, and warm up procedures will govern the meet as if fully set forth in these meet rules.

Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy Acknowledgement

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. There will be at least two safety marshals at this competition, with at least one of each gender.

*Warm up for the Open sessions will begin immediately following the previous session but not before the time above.

**Events in the Open sessions will begin one hour following the start of warm-ups but not before the time above.

Facilities

Saline High School pool is an 8-lane pool with a 4-lane supervised warm-up and warm down area available. Depth at start is 13'6" and 7'4" at turn. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. A Daktronics timing system with 8-lane display will be used.

Course Certification

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4)

Meet Format: This meet is a timed finals meet.

Eligibility

All athletes and clubs registered with Michigan Swimming or another USA Swimming LSC are eligible to participate in this meet.

Entry Procedures

Entries may be submitted to the Administrative Official as of **October 24, 2025 at 9:00 am.** The Administrative Official must receive all entries no later than **November 14, 2025 at 6:00 pm.** Entries must include correct swimmer name (as registered with USA/MS Swimming), age and USA number. All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail at the e-mail address listed in the last section of this meet information packet.

Entry Acceptance and Processing

Entries will be accepted and processed on a first-come, first-served basis in the order in which they are received after the entry open date listed above.

Individual Entry Limits

Friday: Athletes may swim Two (2) events.

Saturday and Sunday: Athletes may swim (4) individual events each day.

Entry Fees

\$6.25 per individual event. Make checks payable to **Saline Swim Team.**

Surcharges

A \$10 facility and \$1.00 per athlete Michigan Swimming athlete surcharge applies.

Refunds

Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the Administrative Official there are no refunds in full or in part unless the "over qualification exception" applies (see MS Rules).

Check In - Check-in will be required and will be located **in the main hallway upstairs near the pool windows**. Check-in will close 15 minutes after warm-up starts.

Marshaling This meet will be self-marshalled.

Seeding

The meet will be seeded after check-in closes. Swimmers who fail to check in for an event will be scratched from that event.

All Friday evening events (500 Free, 400 IM and 1000 Free) and the Open 400 IM in the Sunday PM session will be seeded fastest to slowest. The 500 Free and 400 IM will alternate genders by event.

All other Timed Finals events will be swum slowest to fastest.

Deck Entries/ Time Trials

Athletes must be registered with USA swimming prior to the first day of the meet to be eligible for deck entries. **Deck entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee and time permitting.** Deck entries are **\$8.00** per individual event. Deck entries will count against the daily entry limits of 2 events on Friday and 4 events on Saturday and Sunday.

If timelines allow, **we will offer time trials Sunday PM session only.** The intent being to give high School girl swimmers a chance to swim non-HS events. Time Trials are **\$8.00** per individual event. Time Trials will count against the daily entry limits, no more than two time Trial entries.

Deck entry/Time Trial swimmers are subject to the \$11.00 surcharge if they are not already entered in the meet.

Meet Programs/Admissions

Admission is **\$5.00** per day. Children 12 & under are free with a paying adult. Digital heat sheets will be available free of charge via QR code.

Scoring

No individual or team scores will be kept.

Awards

Ribbons for 1st through 16th for 12 & under events. **No awards** for 13 & over events.

Results

Complete Official meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at <http://www.miswim.org/>. Unofficial results will also be available on flash drive (HY-TEK Team Manager result file) upon request. Teams must provide their own flash drive.

Concessions

Concessions will be available in the main hallway. No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials.

Lost and Found

Articles may be turned in/picked up in the pool office. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained by the Meet Director or a representative for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).

Swimming Safety

Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool and diving well. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee which may include ejection from the meet.

Racing Start Certification

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Deck Personnel/Locker Rooms/Credentialing

Only registered and current coaches, athletes, officials and meet personnel are allowed on the deck. Only athletes are permitted in the locker rooms. Access to the pool deck may only be granted to any other individual in the event of emergency through approval by the Meet Director or the Meet Referee. The Michigan Swimming Board of Directors, Officials Chairs of MS, and the Michigan Swimming Office staff are authorized deck personnel at all MS meets. Personal assistants/helpers of athletes with a disability shall be permitted when requested by an athlete with a disability or a coach of an athlete with a disability.

All individuals seeking access to the pool deck must show a valid digital USA Swimming membership card reflecting good standing in order to receive a deck credential. The credential must be displayed at all times during the meet and will include the host team name as well as the function of the individual being granted access to the pool deck (Coach, Official, Timer, or Meet Personnel). In order to obtain a credential, Coaches and Officials must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet. Meet personnel must return the credential at the conclusion of working each day and be reissued a credential daily.

All access points to the pool deck and locker rooms will either be secured or staffed by a meet worker checking credentials throughout the duration of the meet.

Swimmers with Disabilities

All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests, please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.

First Aid

Supplies will be kept in the pool office.

Medical Supervision

Lifeguards will be onsite throughout the meet for emergencies. There is also an AED onsite.

Facility Items

- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of any facility listed above.
- (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
- (C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions.
- (D) An Emergency Action Plan is available for review and inspection at the pool office.
- (E) To comply with USA Swimming privacy and security policy, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- (F) Deck changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes is **prohibited**.
- (G) Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

General Information and Errors/Omissions

Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the Meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.
