#### **Facilities**

**Groves and Seaholm High Schools,** are an **8** lane pool **with a supervised warm-up and warm down area available**. Depth at start is \_8-14\_¹ and \_3.5-14Ft\_ at turn. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. Colorado timing system with an 8-lane display will be used. There is ample balcony seating for spectators. Lockers are available (provide your own lock).

#### **Course Certification**

The competition courses have not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4)

#### **Meet Format**

12 and under Prelims/Finals. 13 and up timed finals.

# **Eligibility**

All athletes and clubs registered with Michigan Swimming or another USA Swimming LSC are eligible to participate in this meet.

# **Entry Procedures**

Entries may be submitted to the Administrative Official as of **October 5, 2024, 9am.** The Administrative Official must receive all entries no later than **October 25, 2024 11:59pm**. Entries must include correct swimmer name (as registered with USA/MS Swimming), age and USA number. All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail at the e-mail address listed in the last section of this meet information packet.

#### **Entry Acceptance and Processing**

Entries will be accepted and processed on a first come, first served basis in the order in which they are received after the entry open date listed above.

# **Individual Entry Limits**

12 & under swimmers may enter (3) individual events on both Saturday and Sunday. Saturday and Sunday 13 & Over swimmers may enter four (4) individual events.

# **Entry Fees**

**\$7.50** per Prelims/Finals 12 and under individual event, **\$5** per timed finals 13 and up events. Make checks payable to **Atlantis Swimming.** 

# **Surcharges**

A \$1.00 per athlete Michigan Swimming athlete surcharge applies.

#### Refunds

#### **Check In**

Check-in will be required and will be located **outside of the locker rooms**. Check in closes 15 minutes after the start of warmups for each session. If a swimmer does not highlight their name, they will be taken out of the meet.

# Marshaling

Swimmers will be responsible for reporting to the marshaling area when their event is called.

# Seeding

The meet will be **seeded** after check in closes.

#### **Deck Entries**

Deck entries will be allowed. Deck Entries are 10.00 for prelim/final events and 7.00 for 13 and up events.

#### **Meet Programs/Admissions**

Individual session heat sheets will be available for \$4.00 once the session has been seeded. The doors to the spectator area will be open both Saturday and Sunday morning at 7:20am. Admission is \$5 per day.

# **Scoring**

No scores will be kept.

#### **Awards**

Prelim/Final awards will get medals for top 8 and Ribbons for 9-16. No awards for 13 and up swimmers. There will be heat winner prizes.

#### Results

Complete Official meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at <a href="http://www.miswim.org/">http://www.miswim.org/</a>. Unofficial results will also be available on flash drive (HY-TEK Team Manager result file) upon request. Teams must provide their own flash drive.

#### Concessions

Food and beverages will be available in the pool lobby concession area. No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials.

# **Lost and Found**

Articles may be turned in/picked up at **Meet Operations Room**. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained by the Meet Director or a representative for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).

# **Swimming Safety**

Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool and diving well. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee which may include ejection from the meet.

# **Racing Start Certification**

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

# **Deck Personnel/Locker Rooms/Credentialing**

Only registered and current coaches, athletes, officials and meet personnel are allowed on the deck or in locker rooms. Access to the pool deck may only be granted to any other individual in the event of emergency through approval by the Meet Director or the Meet Referee. The Michigan Swimming Board of Directors, Officials Chairs of MS, and the Michigan Swimming Office staff are authorized deck personnel at all MS meets. Personal assistants/helpers of athletes with a disability shall be permitted when requested by an athlete with a disability or a coach of an athlete with a disability.

All individuals seeking access to the pool deck must show a valid digital USA Swimming membership card reflecting good standing in order to receive a deck credential. The credential must be displayed at all times during the meet and will include the host team name as well as the function of the individual being granted access to the pool deck (Coach, Official, Timer, or Meet Personnel). In order to obtain a credential, Coaches and Officials must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet. Meet personnel must return the credential at the conclusion of working each day and be reissued a credential daily.

All access points to the pool deck and locker rooms will either be secured or staffed by a meet worker checking credentials throughout the duration of the meet.

#### **Swimmers with Disabilities**

All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests, please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.

#### First Aid

Supplies will be kept in the **operation room**.

### **Medical Supervision**

First aid supplies and AED device are kept in the operation room.

# **Facility Items**

- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of any facility listed above.
- (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
- (C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions.
- (D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by the Host Club to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection at the **operation room**.
- (E) To comply with USA Swimming privacy and security policy, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- (F) Deck changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes is **prohibited**.
- (G) Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

#### **General Information and Errors/Omissions**

Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the Meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.
