Saturday PM Warm-up will start immediately following the conclusion of the Saturday AM session but not before 11:00 am. Saturday PM events will start one-hour after the start of warm-up, but not before 12:00 pm. Sunday 500 and 1000 session Events will begin 15 minutes after the conclusion of the morning session, not before 11am

Facilities

Waterford Kettering, is a(n) 8 lane pool with a 3 lane supervised warm-up and warm down area available. Depth at start is 8'¹ and 4' at turn. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. Colorado timing with an 8 lane display will be utilized.

Course Certification

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4)

Meet Format

Timed Finals

Eligibility

All athletes and clubs registered with Michigan Swimming or another USA Swimming LSC are eligible to participate in this meet.

Entry Procedures

Entries may be submitted to the Administrative Official as of **January 12, 2026 12noon**. The Administrative Official must receive all entries no later than **January 23, 2026 6pm**. Entries must include correct swimmer name (as registered with USA/MS Swimming), age and USA number. All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail at the e-mail address listed in the last section of this meet information packet.

Entry Acceptance and Processing

Entries will be accepted and processed on a first come, first served basis in the order they are received.

Individual Entry Limits

4 individual events per day.

Entry Fees

\$6.25 per individual event, \$9.00 for the 1000. Make checks payable to **USSC**.

Surcharges

A \$1.00 per athlete Michigan Swimming athlete and \$10 facility surcharge applies.

Refunds

Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the Administrative Official there are no refunds in full or in part unless the "over qualification exception" applies (see MS Rules).

Check In

Check-in will be required and will be located in the hallway leading onto the pool deck. Swimmers who fail to check-in will be scratched from that session's events. Sunday PM Check in will be posted by 9:30 AM and close at 10:30.

Marshaling

This is a self-Marshalled Meet

Seeding

The meet will be **seeded** after entries are closed. Note that the 500 Free and 1000 will be seeded fastest to slowest.

Deck Entries

Deck entries will be allowed at the discretion of the Meet Referee and Meet Director. \$8.50 per event plus applicable surcharges. The 1000 \$12.50.

Meet Programs/Admissions

\$5 Admission, \$3 Heat Sheets for each session

Scoring

No individual or team scoring will be kept.

Awards

Events will be awarded 1-8. 12 & Under events will be awarded 10 & Under and 11-12. 11 & Over events will be awarded 11-12 and 13 and Older.

Results

Complete Official meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at <http://www.miswim.org/>. Unofficial results will also be available on flash drive (HY-TEK Team Manager result file) upon request. Teams must provide their own flash drive.

Concessions

No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials. Concessions will be available in the lobby for spectators.

Lost and Found

Articles may be turned in/picked up at **the pool office**. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained by the Meet Director or a representative for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).

Swimming Safety

Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool and diving well. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee which may include ejection from the meet.

Racing Start Certification

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Deck Personnel/Locker Rooms/Credentialing

Only registered and current coaches, athletes, officials and meet personnel are allowed on the deck. Only athletes are permitted in the locker rooms. Access to the pool deck may only be granted to any other individual in the event of emergency through approval by the Meet Director or the Meet Referee. The Michigan Swimming Board of Directors, Officials Chairs of MS, and the Michigan Swimming Office staff are authorized deck personnel at all MS meets. Personal assistants/helpers of athletes with a disability shall be permitted when requested by an athlete with a disability or a coach of an athlete with a disability.

All individuals seeking access to the pool deck must show a valid digital USA Swimming membership card reflecting good standing in order to receive a deck credential. The credential must be displayed at all times during the meet and will include the host team name as well as the function of the individual being granted access to the pool deck (Coach, Official, Timer, or Meet Personnel). In order to obtain a credential, Coaches and Officials must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet. Meet personnel must return the credential at the conclusion of working each day and be reissued a credential daily.

All access points to the pool deck and locker rooms will either be secured or staffed by a meet worker checking credentials throughout the duration of the meet.

Swimmers with Disabilities

All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests, please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.

First Aid

Supplies will be kept in **the pool office**.

Medical Supervision

Lifeguards will be available for emergencies or First Aid.

Facility Items

- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of any facility listed above.
- (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
- (C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions.
- (D) An Emergency Action Plan is available for review and inspection at the **Pool Office**.
- (E) To comply with USA Swimming privacy and security policy, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- (F) Deck changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes is **prohibited**.
- (G) Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

General Information and Errors/Omissions

Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the Meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.
